Dr. J. Turlo welcomed participants and presented the timetable of this seminar.

Ad. 2.

- Dr. J. Turlo reported the last activities of EU ISE Project, but especially informed about preparation of the elaborated materials for publication in the form of book on: "Effective use of ICT in Science Education".
- There was lively discussion - how to disseminate the Torun group results during the Annual XVth Polish Association of Science Teachers Meeting in September. We decided to register not only plenary lecture on our activity: "How ICT is/should be used in science education?" but also some workshops and poster related to this topic.

Ad.3. The particular group representatives reported on their last activities at school: Mrs Agnieszka Dyszczyńska – about chemistry with ICT, Ms Barbara Gurtowska and Mr Piotr Felski –about biology with ICT and Mr Waldemar Gancarz- about applications of ICT in physics teaching. All of them promised to organise the short training sessions for their school colleagues on the effective use of ICT in teaching science.

Ad.5. The most experienced teachers in the application of whiteboard at school lessons (Mrs J. Gancarz and Mr W. Gancarz) have acquainted participants of Seminar with this new ICT tool in our school practice.
